

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About our clinic

We have a nurse, doctors and medical students (called residents) who will help to provide your care.

Sometimes we may ask you to repeat your health information; this is because we are a teaching hospital and want to make sure that everyone has the information they need for your care.

Patients are usually sent to the clinic so that we can help diagnose a health issue.

You may have been referred:

- By staff in an emergency department after a recent visit;
- By your family doctor;
- · By your surgeon; or
- For follow-up care.

How long is the wait to see staff at the clinic?

We will try to see patients with the most serious concerns first. The wait for an appointment could range from one day to approximately two weeks.

What will happen at your visit?

Your appointment will be about an hour long. Our nurse, doctors and medical resident will meet with you.

Sometimes the hematologist will order some blood work or other tests for more information.

We will discuss your treatment plan and next steps with you.

Getting ready for your visit with us

You may eat and drink as you normally would before you come for your appointment.

Please wear loose-fitting clothes and comfortable shoes.

Please bring the following with you:

 All of the medications you are currently taking in their original containers;
Your health card;
The first and last name of your family doctor;
A snack – especially if you have diabetes; and
A family member or friend for support, if possible.
